



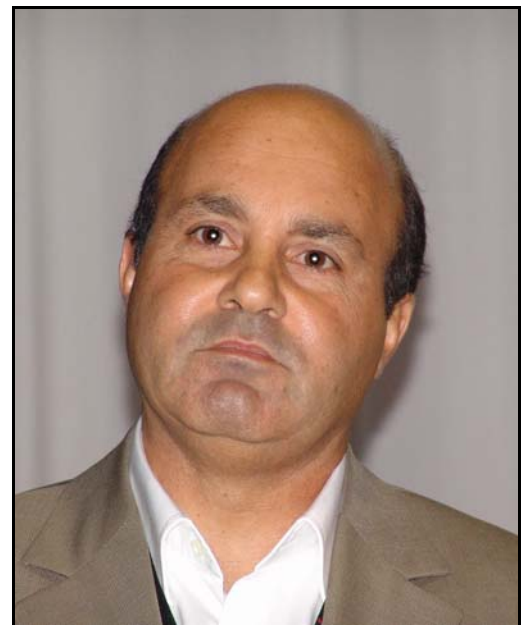
WAIA, iVEC and the IEEE Society on Social Implications of Technology proudly present:
